

Transparency in Coverage

A recent federal regulation called the **Transparency in Coverage Rule** along with the **Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021** (CAA) requires Cigna and employers to provide information regarding negotiated service rates and allowed amounts for out-of-network services that are contracted between health plans and health care providers. The method by which this information is made available is with machine readable files (MRFs). The MRFs are formatted to allow researchers, regulators, and application developers to easily access and analyze data.

This link leads to the machine readable files that are made available in response to the federal Transparency in Coverage Rule and includes negotiated service rates and out-of-network allowed amounts between health plans and healthcare providers.
